RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE PROGRAMS, PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES TO BE FUNDED UNDER 5% OF THE ANNUAL ESTIMATED INCOME OF THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT - CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION COUNCIL (MDRRM-CCA) FOR FY 2025

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the state to uphold people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the country's institutional capacity for Disaster Risk Reduction and Management and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;
